The Chinese word for “ship” consists of the symbols for “mouth” and “eight.” To some this suggests that the ark was a boat which carried eight persons.

Nu-Wah is regarded as an ancient Chinese ancestor and hero. The Chinese characters in this name are not used for their meaning but for their sound. Thus Nu-Wah (Noah?) could be indicated as the ancestor of the Chinese.
